CAMPING REGULATIONS

CAMPING PRICES:

\$15.00 PER DAY - PER PERSON 14 OR OLDER

\$60.00 FOR 2 WEEKS - PER PERSON 14 OR OLDER

\$150 FOR 3 MONTHS - PER PERSON 14 OR OLDER

- ***TRASH:** Clean Campsites must be maintained at all times.
- ***CONTAINMENT:** All Motorhomes and Trailers must be self-contained. If not available, a blue boy will be Sufficient for all gray water and waste. Gray water must be properly disposed of.
- ***FIRES:** Fires are allowed, but must be closely monitored and properly contained.
- ***ANIMALS:** All Campers and Guest are required to follow the Quechan Animal Control Ordinance.
- * **CONDUCT:** Disturbances and/or Disorderly Conduct **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- * **DRUGS USAGE:** The Quechan Tribe has a **ZERO TOLERANCE DRUG POLICY.** Anyone using or involved with drugs, will either be arrested or have their camping privileges revoked. Federal Law supersedes State Law on the reservation, so this includes Marijuana.
- * **FIREARMS:** Loaded Firearms will not be permitted in campsites
- ***CLUTTER-FREE:** Campers are permitted 1 Motorhome or Trailer, and 1 automobile.
- * **CRIME:** Crimes committed on or off the reservation **WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.**
- ***LEGAL DOCUMENTATION:** Quechan Fish & Game does not deal with legal documents, including Medical, Medicare, Social Services, Postal Services, V.A. Benefits or Residency.
- ***NO FISHING:** Campers are not allowed to fish. A valid fishing permit is required and must be purchased.
- ***REVOCATION:** A permit can be pulled at any time for any reason without a refund.
