All dogs and cats should have their first rabies vaccination followed by a booster shot within the first year. Thereafter, they should receive a vaccination every three years. Dogs and cats must be 3 months (12 weeks) old before they can be vaccinated.

- A cat placed in a cage, burlap bag, or pillow case, is much easier to handle.
- Dogs should be leashed at all times during the clinic.
