#### MEMORANDUM

**IN RESPONSE TO PRESIDENT TRUMPS EXECUTIVE ORDERS REGARDING IMMIGRATION THE FORT YUMA QUECHAN TRIBE ANNOUNCES THE FOLLOWING.**

Effective February 11, 2025, per Quechan Tribal Council, Tribal membership will be allowed one Tribal Identification card free of charge until August 11, 2025. If you have a current ID card that is not expired, you do not have to obtain a new card.

Should your Tribal Identification card need replacing after receiving your one free card you will have to pay a \$15.00 fee, or you may get a paper copy at no cost. You can only be issued one ID card every 30 days due to the high demand. A paper copy will be provided as a replacement during this duration.

- Children 11 years of age and older will be able to receive their first Tribal ID.
- Children 10 and younger can receive a Certificate of Indian blood (CIB) with their photo attached.

Our office hours will be Monday through Friday from 8am to 5pm. However, we can do ID's at 7:30am and 12:00pm to 1:00pm by appointment only.
