



Warm and Dry Conditions Continue Most of This Week | Weak Weather System
Wednesday

KEY POINTS

- Tranquil weather conditions with temperatures 5-10 degrees above the seasonal normal much of the week
Warmest weather will occur today, Saturday, and Sunday with many lower desert communities nearing or exceeding 80 degrees
Chance (15-40%) of light showers (any localized rainfall less than 0.10") with occasionally breezy conditions (gusts 20-30 mph) Wednesday

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence. The weather hazard with the greatest risk will be listed first in the matrix.

Table with 8 columns (Days: Tue 2/20 to Mon 2/26) and 4 rows (Regions: Phoenix Metro Area, High Terrain SC AZ, Southwest Arizona, Southeast California). Risk levels are mostly 'Little to None', with 'Wind' noted for Southeast California on Wed 2/21.
