



## Above Normal Temperatures and Minor Heat Risk Persists | Cooler and Windy Conditions Arrive Sunday

### KEY POINTS

- Highs in the low to mid 90s across the lower deserts and mid to upper 80s in the higher terrain resulting in a minor HeatRisk.
- A weather system will cool temperatures down to normal on Sunday and Monday.
- Widespread gusty winds Sunday afternoon and evening.

### CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

- Added a minor risk for gusty winds across the region on Sunday
- Removed minor heat risk for southeast CA, southwest AZ, and AZ High Terrain on Sunday

### WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence. The weather hazard with the greatest risk will be listed first in the matrix.

Afternoon highs in the mid to upper 80s through this weekend.

Difficult driving conditions for high profile vehicles. Loose or unsecured objects may be blown away.

**Timing:**

Sunday

Gusts up to 30-35 mph, locally 40+ mph

## Southwest Arizona

**Timing:**

Daily except Sunday

Afternoon highs in the low to mid 90s through this weekend.

**Timing:**

Sunday

Gusts up to 25-35 mph

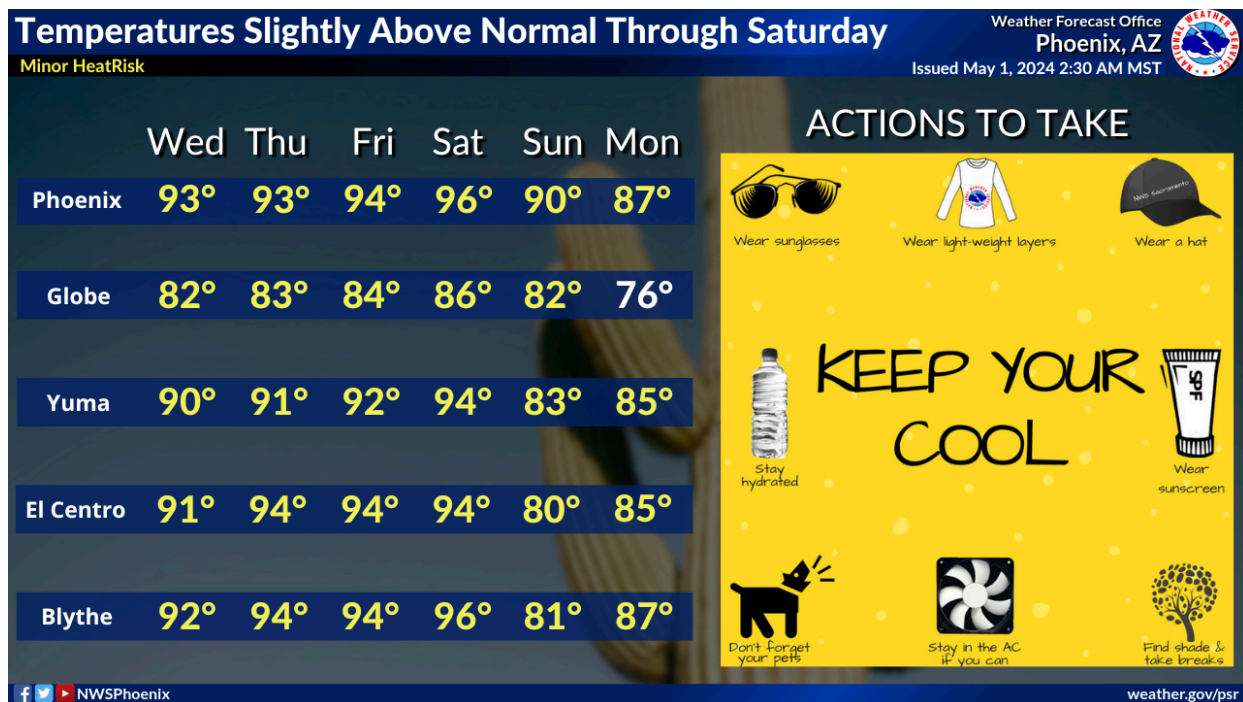

# Forecast Maximum Wind Gusts

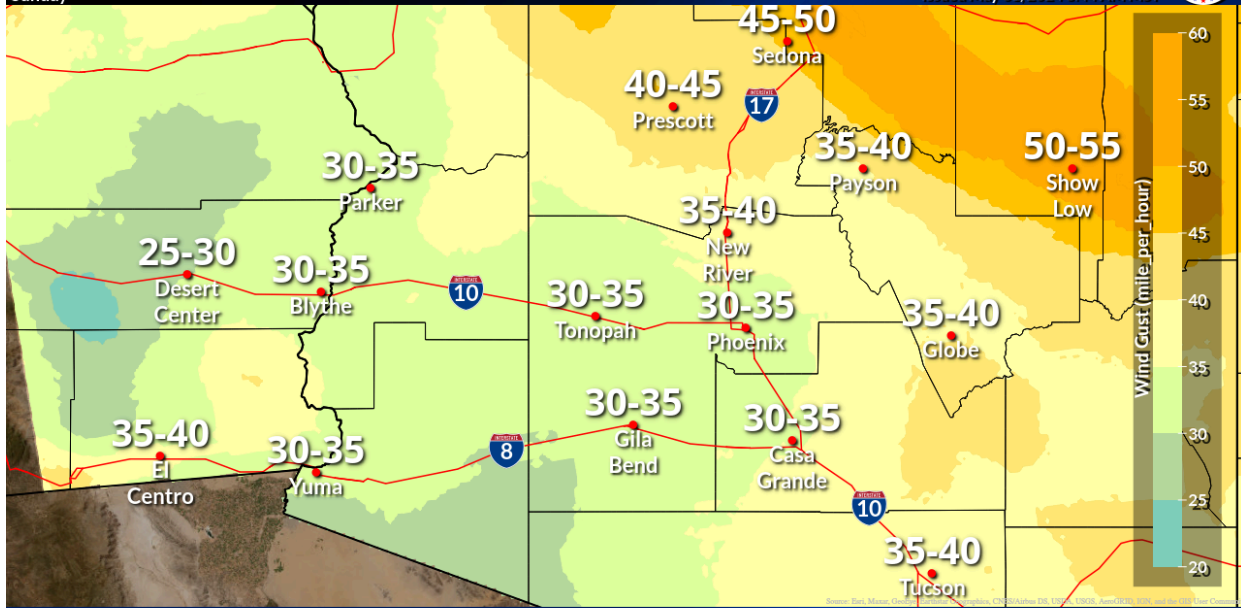
