- Local Moderate HeatRisk on Friday and Sunday with widespread Moderate HeatRisk across the lower deserts on Saturday with highs in the upper 90s to low 100s
- Frequent afternoon breezes around 25 mph combined with very dry conditions resulting in a locally elevated fire danger
