KEY POINTS

- Breezy to locally windy this afternoon, with potential for 40+ mph peak gusts.
- Elevated to near critical fire weather conditions this afternoon.
- Light showers in South-Central Arizona this afternoon with minimal rainfall (<0.10").
- · Seasonably dry conditions with afternoon breeziness Tuesday onward.
- Seasonably hot each day with widespread Minor HeatRisk as lower desert highs climb into the 90s.

- Added mention of light showers this afternoon in South-Central AZ

Phoenix Metro Area ≝ Wind

Impacts:

Loose or unsecured objects may be blown away and/or toppled.

Timing:

Today

- Afternoon wind gusts up to 30-35 mph, with localized gusts in excess of 40 mph with light showers.
- Chance of 40+ mph wind gusts: 40-50%
- Localized blowing dust may briefly lower visibility near exposed open desert areas in or near the metro area, like along I-10 and SR-347 just south of the metro.



Impacts:

Gusty winds, dry fuels, and low humidity could lead to easier fire starts and the potential for rapid spread of new or existing fires.

Timing:

Today

Afternoon wind gusts to around 25-35 mph, locally and briefly 40+ mph, with RHs between 10-15%



Impacts:

Minor Risk for heat-related illnesses for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily

• Seasonally hot with high temperatures in the middle 90s.

High Terrain SC AZ



Impacts:

Minor Risk for heat-related illnesses for those extremely sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily

• Seasonally hot with high temperatures between 85-90 degrees.



Impacts:

Gusty winds, dry fuels, and low humidity could lead to easier fire starts and the potential for rapid spread of new or existing fires.

Timing:

Today

• Afternoon wind gusts up to 30-40 mph, with RHs between 10-15% for a few hours in the early to mid afternoon




