Thunderstorm Chances Continue through This Week | Warming Temperatures through the Middle of This Week

KEY POINTS

- Hot and humid conditions will continue through this week. Slight warming trend anticipated through the middle
 of the week. Widespread Moderate HeatRisk, with isolated areas of Major HeatRisk, during this period.
- Thunderstorm potential continue today, with best chances across the higher terrain areas. Small chances (10-30%) of strong outflow winds (35+ mph gusts).
- Daily thunderstorm chances continue through this week, but will be mostly relegated to higher terrain areas of southcentral AZ.

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Details

- Moderate HeatRisk this week, with localized (less than 10% coverage) Major HeatRisk developing by the middle of this week
- Highs ranging between 107-112°F through the middle of this week before slight cooling temperatures through the end of this week
- Overnight lows 85-92°F through the middle of this week



Impacts

Gusty winds, lightning, and localized heavy rainfall

Timing:

Today

Details:

- Thunderstorm Chances Today: 5-15% across the Phoenix metro, 15-25% in higher terrain of Pinal and far eastern Maricopa counties
- Thunderstorm Threats/Impacts Today: Strong outflow winds (10-30% chance of winds gusting 35+ mph)
- Generally low (5-15%) thunderstorm chances Tuesday onward

Higher Terrain SC AZ



Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- Moderate HeatRisk through this week
- Highs ranging from 98-105°F through the middle of this week, before slight cooling temperatures late this week



Impacts:

Gusty winds, lightning, and localized heavy rainfall

Timing:

Daily through Thursday

Details:

- Thunderstorm Chances Today: 20-40%
- Thunderstorm Threats/Impacts Today: Strong outflow winds (10-30% chance of winds gusting 35+ mph) and localized heavy downpours (low threat for localized flooding relegated to burn scars)
- Daily thunderstorm chances continue through Thursday, with chances gradually decreasing throughout the week

Southwest Arizona

Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- Moderate HeatRisk through this week, with localized (less than 10% coverage) Major HeatRisk developing by the middle of this week
- Highs range generally from 105-111°F through the middle of this week before slight cooling temperatures late this week



Impacts:

Gusty winds, lightning, and brief heavy downpours

Timing:

Today

Details:

- Thunderstorm Chances Today: 10-20% chance of thunderstorms anticipated mainly over higher terrain spots in La Paz County
- Thunderstorm Threats/Impacts Today: 10-30% chance of gusty outflow winds of 35+ mph

Southeast California



Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Details:

- Moderate HeatRisk through this week, with areas (10-20% coverage) of Major HeatRisk through most of this week
- \bullet Highs range generally from 107-113°F through the middle of this week before slight cooling late this week

Impacts:

Moderate Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

Timing:

Daily Moderate HeatRisk

Details:


- Moderate HeatRisk through this week
- \bullet Highs range generally from 101-110°F (93-98°F) for the lower (higher) elevations through the middle of this week before slight cooling temperatures late this week




