KEY POINTS

- Near to above normal temperatures nearly every day with widespread Moderate HeatRisk in the lower deserts
- Dry and mostly sunny today
- Increase in moisture Tuesday bringing a return of daily AZ high terrain storms
- Slight chance (15-25%) for showers and storms in the Phoenix area late-Tuesday through early-Wednesday

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

• Lowered risk level to Minor for Wednesday for Phoenix Metro and added Thunderstorm mention

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

- Above normal most days with highs 104-110°F
- Slight chance (20-40%) of reaching 110°F Today and Tuesday
- Near to slightly below normal Wednesday with highs 100-104°F



Impacts:

Strong gusty winds, lightning, and locally heavy rainfall

Timing:

Late-Tuesday & Early-Wednesday

Details:

• Shower and thunderstorm chances: 15-25%

• Near to slightly above normal temperatures with afternoon highs 92-104°F



Impacts:






