

Cooling Trend Through the Week with Increased Rain Chances by the End of the Week

KEY POINTS

- Record high temperatures expected in Phoenix today
- Gradual decline in temperatures through the work week.
- Storm System moving across the Desert Southwest will bring much cooler temperatures as well as increased breeziness and rain chances by the end of the week.

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

• Added minor thunderstorm risk for south-central AZ Friday-Saturday
