



Above Normal Temperatures Starting Tuesday

KEY POINTS

- Warming up over the next few days with lower desert highs in the mid to upper 90s Wednesday-Sunday
Dry conditions throughout the entire week

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

- Highs in the 80s to as high as the lower 90s Wednesday-Sunday

Low Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

**Timing:**

Daily

**Details:**

- Highs mostly in the mid 90s Wednesday-Sunday

Low Risk for heat-related illnesses for pets, livestock, and those who are sensitive to heat, especially those without effective cooling and/or adequate hydration.

**Timing:**

Daily

**Details:**

- Highs mostly in the mid 90s Wednesday-Sunday
