# **Well Above Normal Temperatures and Dry Conditions Expected This Week**

### **KEY POINTS**

- Highs in the low to mid 70s across the lower deserts today with a gradual warming trend through mid-week.
- Record highs around 79-81° will be possible Wednesday-Saturday (mainly in Phoenix).
- Dry conditions are expected to persist all week with overall light winds.

#### **WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK**

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.


