



## Freezing Morning Low Temperatures Continue Early This Week

### KEY POINTS

- **Freeze Warnings** are in effect this morning and tonight/Tuesday morning across portions of South-Central and Southwest AZ.
- **Warming temperatures** during the middle of the week reaching slightly above normal before cooling again starting Friday.
- **Slight precipitation chances (10-20%)** primarily focused over the South-Central AZ high terrain late this week.

### CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

- Freeze Warnings have been issued for Tuesday morning for portions of South-Central and Southwest AZ.

### WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.

## Phoenix Metro

**Impacts:**

Bring in sensitive plants & take precautions to protect other property from freezing temperatures.

**Timing:**

This morning and Tuesday morning

**Details:**

- **Freeze Warnings are in effect this morning and Tuesday morning, including the Phoenix Metro Area both days.**
- Low temperatures at or below freezing across portions of Maricopa County including the outskirts of the Phoenix Metro through Tuesday.
- Northwest Pinal County could see hard freeze conditions with morning lows at or below 28 degrees.

## Higher Terrain SC AZ

**Impacts:**

Bring in sensitive plants & take precautions to protect other property from freezing temperatures.

**Timing:**

Through Tuesday morning

**Details:**

- **A Freeze Warning is in effect this morning for the Tonto Basin, Globe/Miami, San Carlos, Superior, and Dipping Springs areas.**
- The Globe/Miami, San Carlos, and Tonto Basin/Roosevelt areas could see hard freeze conditions with morning lows at or below 28 degrees through Tuesday morning.

## Southwest AZ

**Impacts:**

Bring in sensitive plants & take precautions to protect other property from freezing temperatures.

**Timing:**

This morning and Tuesday morning

**Details:**

- **Freeze Warnings are in effect this morning and Tuesday morning for the Gila River Valley, and this morning for Aguila Valley, and Central La Paz County.**
- Low temperatures at or below freezing in low lying areas and river valleys of La Paz and Yuma Counties.

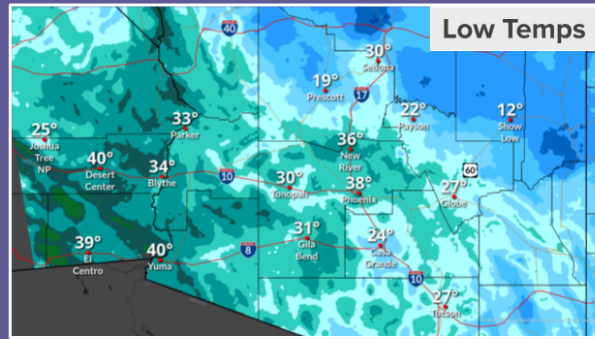
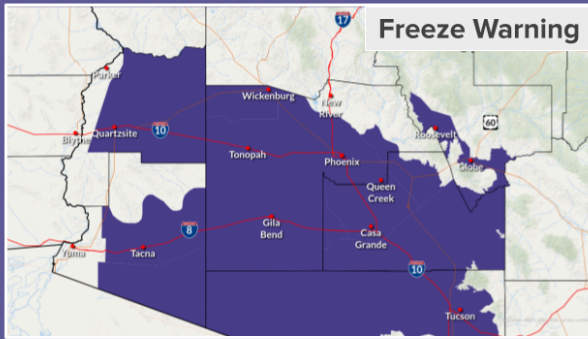

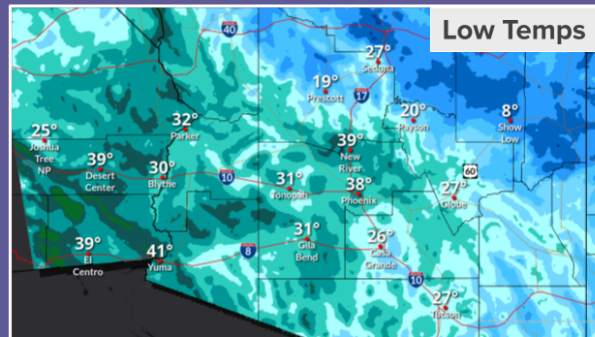
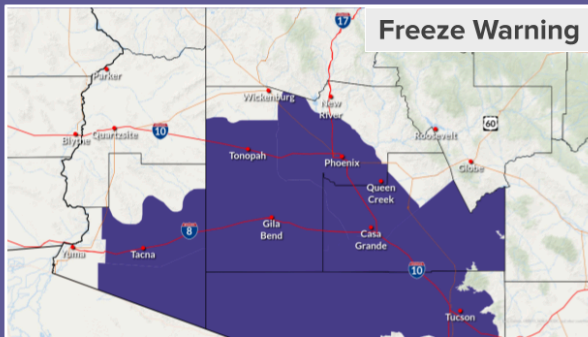

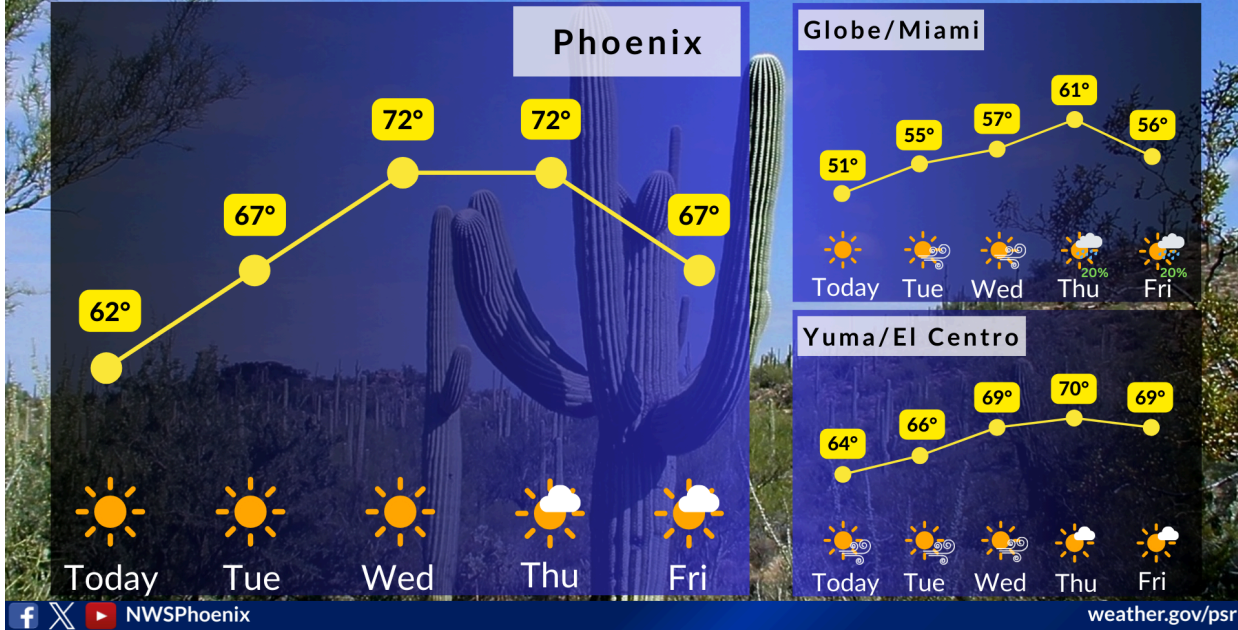
