# **Freezing Morning Low Temperatures Continue Early This Week**

# **KEY POINTS**

- Freeze Warnings are in effect this morning and tonight/Tuesday morning across portions of South-Central and Southwest AZ.
- Warming temperatures during the middle of the week reaching slightly above normal before cooling again starting Friday.
- Slight precipitation chances (10-20%) primarily focused over the South-Central AZ high terrain late this week.

- Low temperatures at or below freezing across portions of Maricopa County including the outskirts of the Phoenix Metro through Tuesday.
- Northwest Pinal County could see hard freeze conditions with morning lows at or below 28 degrees.

## Timing:

Through Tuesday morning

## **Details:**

- A Freeze Warning is in effect this morning for the Tonto Basin, Globe/Miami, San Carlos, Superior, and Dipping Springs areas.
- The Globe/Miami, San Carlos, and Tonto Basin/Roosevelt areas could see hard freeze conditions with morning lows at or below 28 degrees through Tuesday morning.

## **Details:**


- Freeze Warnings are in effect this morning and Tuesday morning for the Gila River Valley, and this morning for Aguila Valley, and Central La Paz County.




