



Unsettled Weather Through Mid Week | Little to No Weather Impacts

KEY POINTS

- A few periods of light showers through Wednesday. Overall impacts will be minimal with light precipitation amounts.
- Light snow possible above 4000 feet across JTNP today with amounts generally an inch or less.
- Light snow generally above 4500 feet across AZ high terrain Tuesday night - Wednesday night.
- Below normal temperatures through mid-week with highs from the upper 50s to the mid 60s across the lower deserts. Turning much warmer next weekend.

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worst case scenario.

Spotty Showers Through Midweek

Weather Forecast Office
Phoenix, AZ
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Overview

- A low pressure system will slowly move through the region Today through Wednesday
- Cooler temperatures
 - ◆ Lower Desert Highs: Upper-50s to Lower-60s
- Periods of spotty light rain showers
- Light snow showers, mainly above 4000 ft

Details

Potential Impacts: Wet roads, slower commute times, small hail, a rumble of thunder, light snow accumulations along some higher elevation roadways like US-60

Forecast Rainfall	Lower Deserts 0.00-0.20"	Higher Terrain 0.10-0.40"
3-Day Exceedance Chance*	> 0.01"	> 0.10"
AZ & CA Lower Deserts	60-80%	30-40%
High Terrain N & E of Phoenix	80-95%	60-70%

*If rain falls, the chance any point location exceeds the specified value.
