



Well Above Normal Temperatures Much of this Week

KEY POINTS

- Above normal temperatures throughout the week. Highs in the 80-85°F range for the lower deserts today and Tuesday, resulting in a Minor HeatRisk. Wednesday will mark a slight cooling trend, but highs will stay 5-10° above normal into the weekend.
- Dry conditions will persist all week.

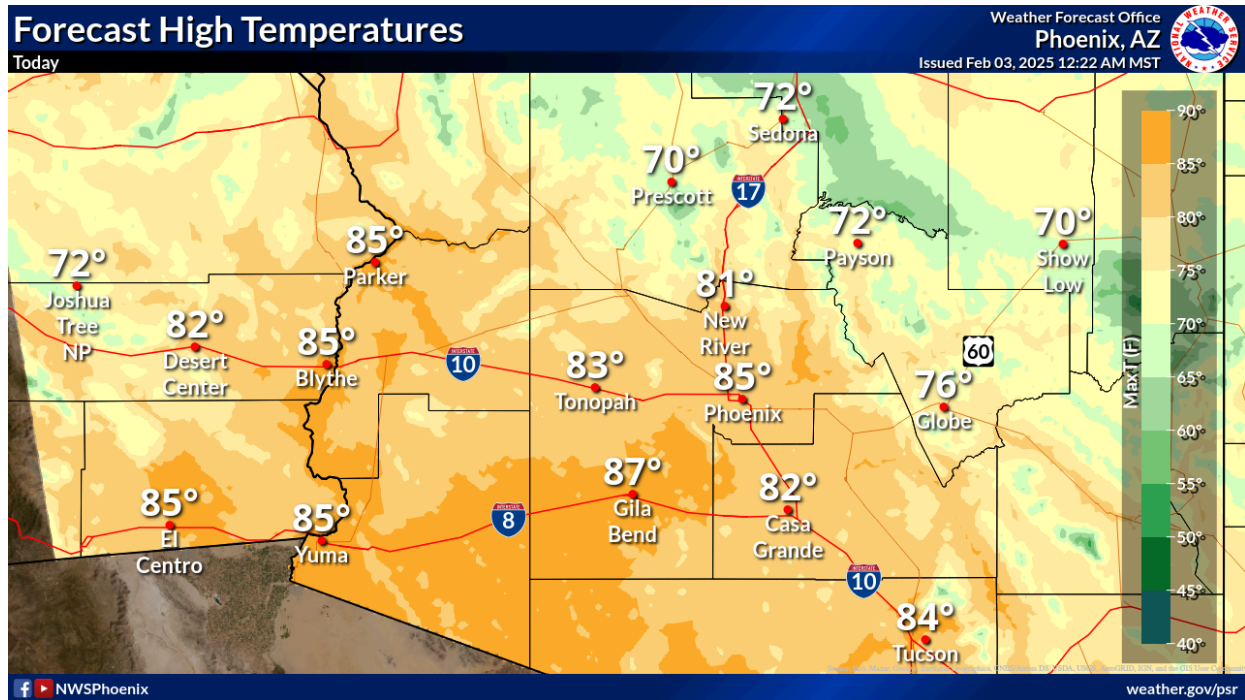

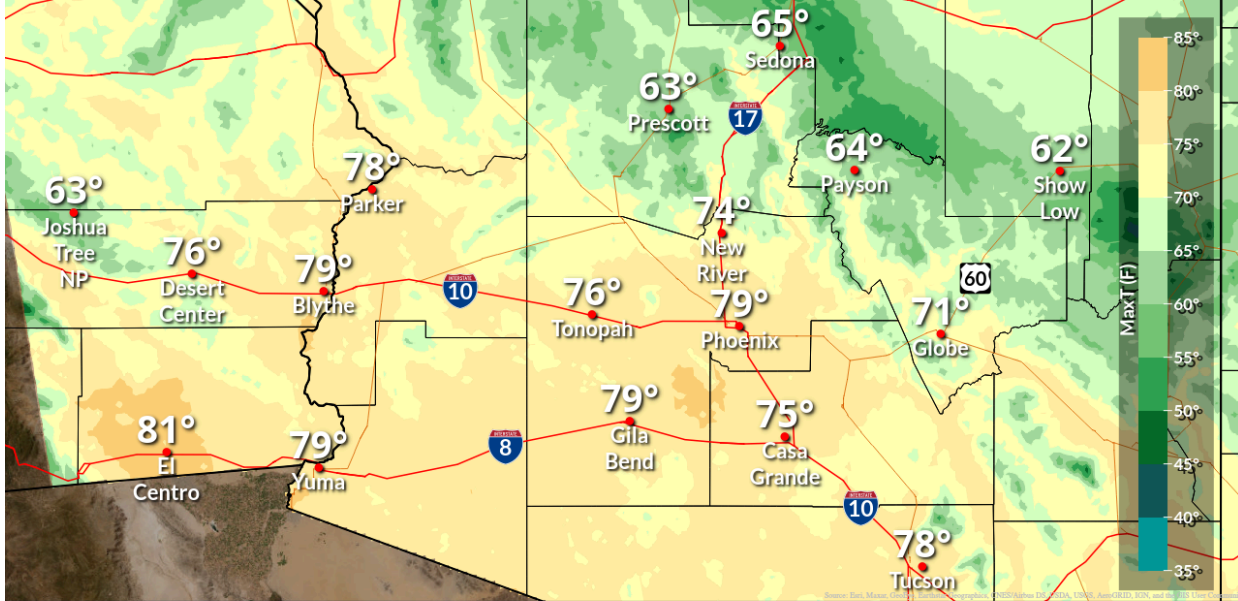

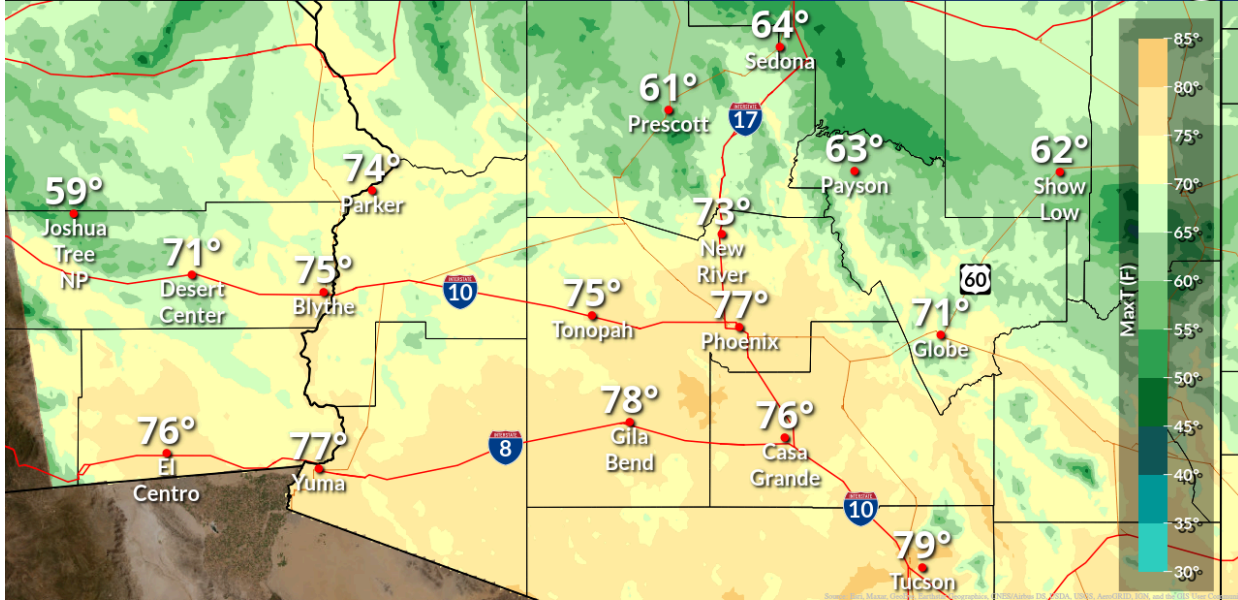
