Rain Tuesday | Strong Weather System Thursday with Wind, T-Storms, & Snow

KEY POINTS

- Weather system #1: Tuesday/Tuesday night Widespread light to moderate rain with a few isolated thunderstorms possible but overall minor risk. Snow levels above 6000 feet.
- Weather system #2: Thursday/Thursday night More potent system with windy conditions areawide, chance for a few strong to severe thunderstorms (mainly SC AZ), and moderate snow above 4000 feet possible.

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

- Added thunderstorm threat over AZ lower deserts Thursday and snow over higher terrain
- Increased wind threat on Thursday to moderate

WEATHER RISK OUTLOOK

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.




