



Abnormally Warm This Week | Near Record Highs Today-Wednesday

KEY POINTS

- Upper-end Minor HeatRisk through Thursday (localized Moderate HeatRisk Tuesday) with lower desert highs 90s. Cooling trend Friday into Saturday with highs closer to normal.
- Record to near record highs Today-Wednesday. 20-50% probability of the warmest lower deserts reaching 100°F on Tuesday.
- Dry conditions will prevail this week

CHANGES FROM PREVIOUS BRIEFING

Increased HeatRisk to Moderate for the lower deserts on Tuesday

Risk levels incorporate potential impacts from weather hazards and likelihood of occurrence for a reasonable worse case scenario.
